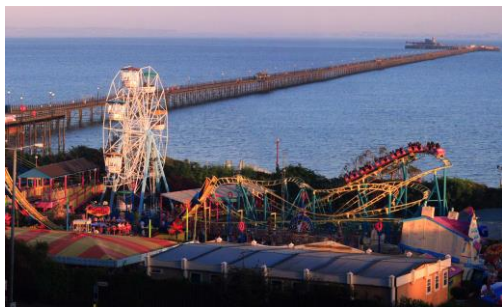


A PDW for Early-Career Scholars on Innovation, Technology and R&D Management
